#### RTP/SCS Investments in Transit



- \$213 billion in transit capital and operations/maintenance investments through 2040
- Focused future growth in population and employment near transit
- Expected growth in per capital ridership
- Increased greenhouse gas reduction targets set by state for 2020 RTP/SCS update



#### **SCAG/UCLA Study Objectives**



- To understand why transit ridership is declining, UCLA analyzed:
  - Changes in transit supply, demand, and finance
  - Changes in the population of likely transit users
  - Changes in rider demographics
